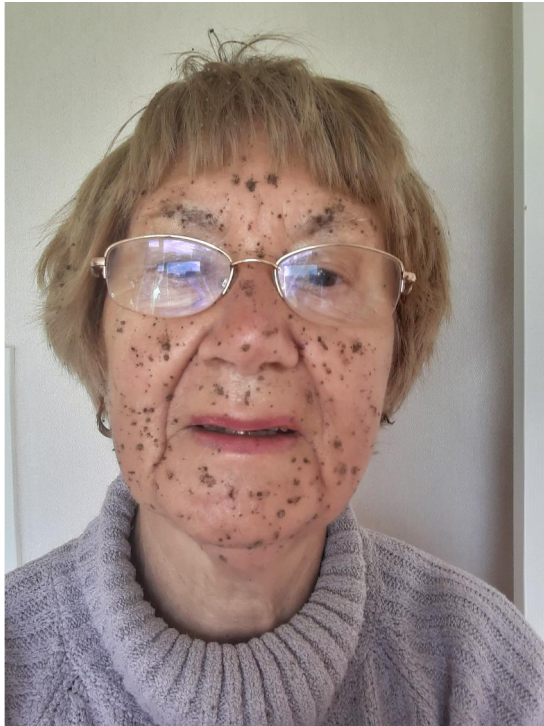


Here's one from Shirley which got missed from the last newsletter. It was sent in response to what we were getting up to.
